# LATEST MEASURES



- President Sebastián Piñera appointed engineer Héctor Vallejos Pérez as the new director of the Antofagasta Health Service, a position that was competed by the Senior Public Management System.
- Health authorities highlighted the intense supervision deployed within the framework of National Holidays. According to preliminary information, the authorities highlighted the more than 60 thousand audits carried out at the metropolitan level during the long weekend.
- The Undersecretary of Assistance Networks, Arturo Zúñiga, called for the proper use of the assistance network in National Holidays.
- Undersecretary of Health, Paula Daza, made an inspection visit in the commune of Las Condes to verify in the field the compliance with the sanitary regulations and the implementation of the inspection by the professionals of the RM Health Seremi.
- The Institute of Public Health (ISP) reported the list of IgG and IgM antibody kits that are reported on the official websites of regulatory authorities of high health surveillance in medical devices.
