

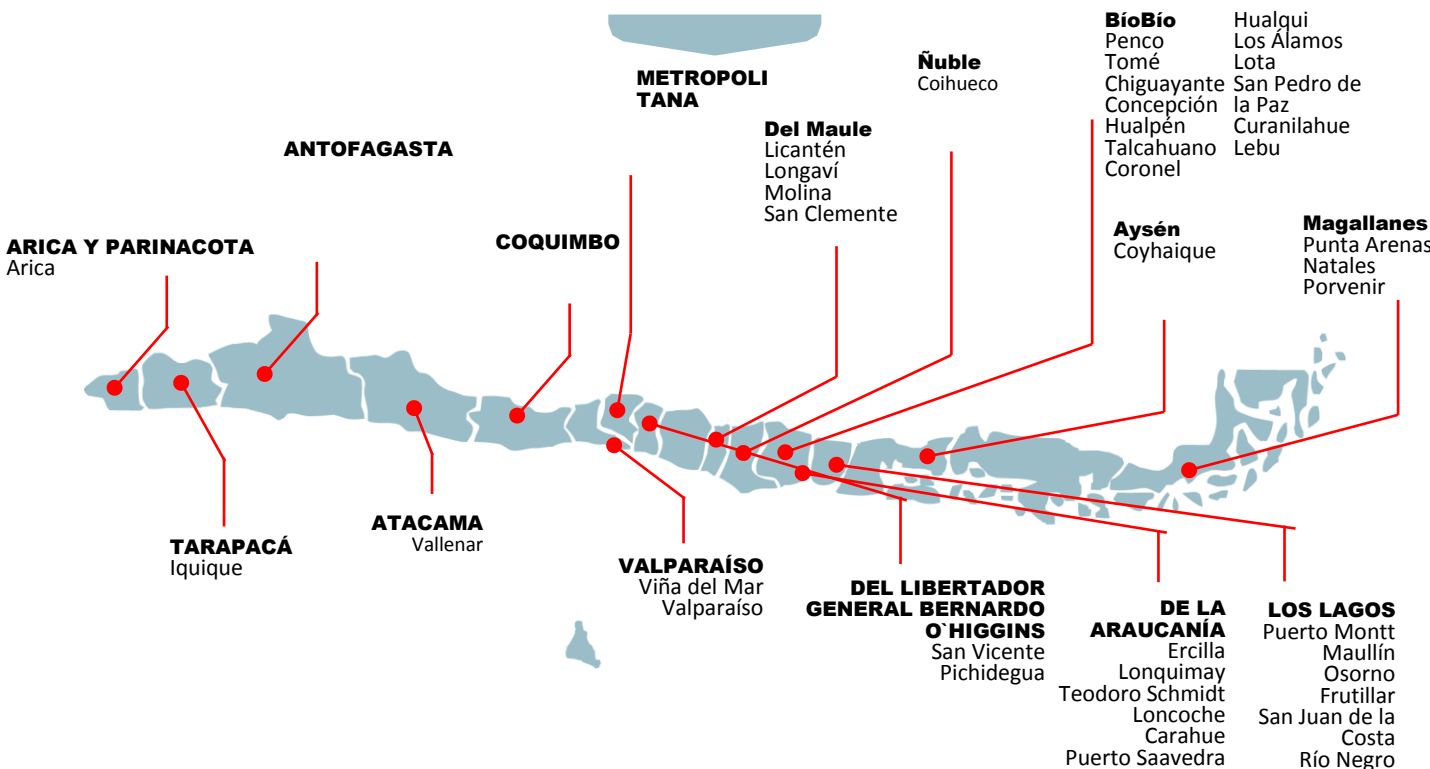

# LATEST MEASURES

- The President of the Republic, Sebastián Piñera, announced the National Budget that in which he considered an important item for the Ministry of Health, which translates into an increase of 8.9% compared to the financing provided this year. In this way, the Ministry of Health will have a budget of \$ 9,714,843 to strengthen Health, face the Coronavirus and advance in mental health. Additionally, the President reported extraordinary resources to buy vaccines against Covid-19 and resolve waiting lists derived from the pandemic.
- The Ministry of Health authorized the development of two clinical studies of vaccines against Covid-19 in Chile. These are the vaccines developed by Sinovac Biotech Co., Ltd. and Janssen Pharmaceutical Companies, the effectiveness of which will be examined through analysis in the national territory.
- The Public Health Institute (ISP) reported the list of IgG and IgM antibody kits that are reported on the official websites of regulatory authorities of high health surveillance in medical devices.
- Authorities of the Ministry of Health reported that as of Saturday, October 3, the communes of Alto Hospicio, Copiapó, Tierra Amarilla, Ovalle, La Calera, Paine, Renca, Santa Cruz, Teno, Maule, Ñuble, Chillán, Chillán Viejo, Angol, Renaico, Temuco, Padre Las Casas, Villarrica, Lautaro, Galvarino, Nueva Imperial, Victoria, Cunco, Cholchol, Río Bueno, Corral, Valdivia and Paillaco passed into Transition. Likewise, the communes of Coihueco, Osorno, Frutillar, San Juan de la Costa, Río Negro, Loncoche, Carahue and Puerto Saavedra were quarantined.
- The authority announced that to prevent mobility for the long weekend of October 12, sanitary cords will be established from Friday, October 9 from 6:00 p.m. to Monday 12 to 11 p.m. in Greater Valparaíso, Concepción , Temuco, Padre Las Casas and the entire Metropolitan Region ”.
- Undersecretary of Assistance Networks, Arturo Zúñiga, inaugurated a new SAR in the Biobío region. The SAR Boca Sur is the second health facility of this type located in the commune of San Pedro de la Paz. These two centers will soon be joined by three other Primary Health Care campuses in the region.
- Minister of Health, Enrique Paris, expressed his concern about COVID-19 cases in regions and called for compliance with sanitary measures. The health authority reinforced the need to maintain the use of a mask, respect physical distancing and maintain hand washing as ways to prevent the spread and contribute to the mitigation of the pandemic in the country.
