

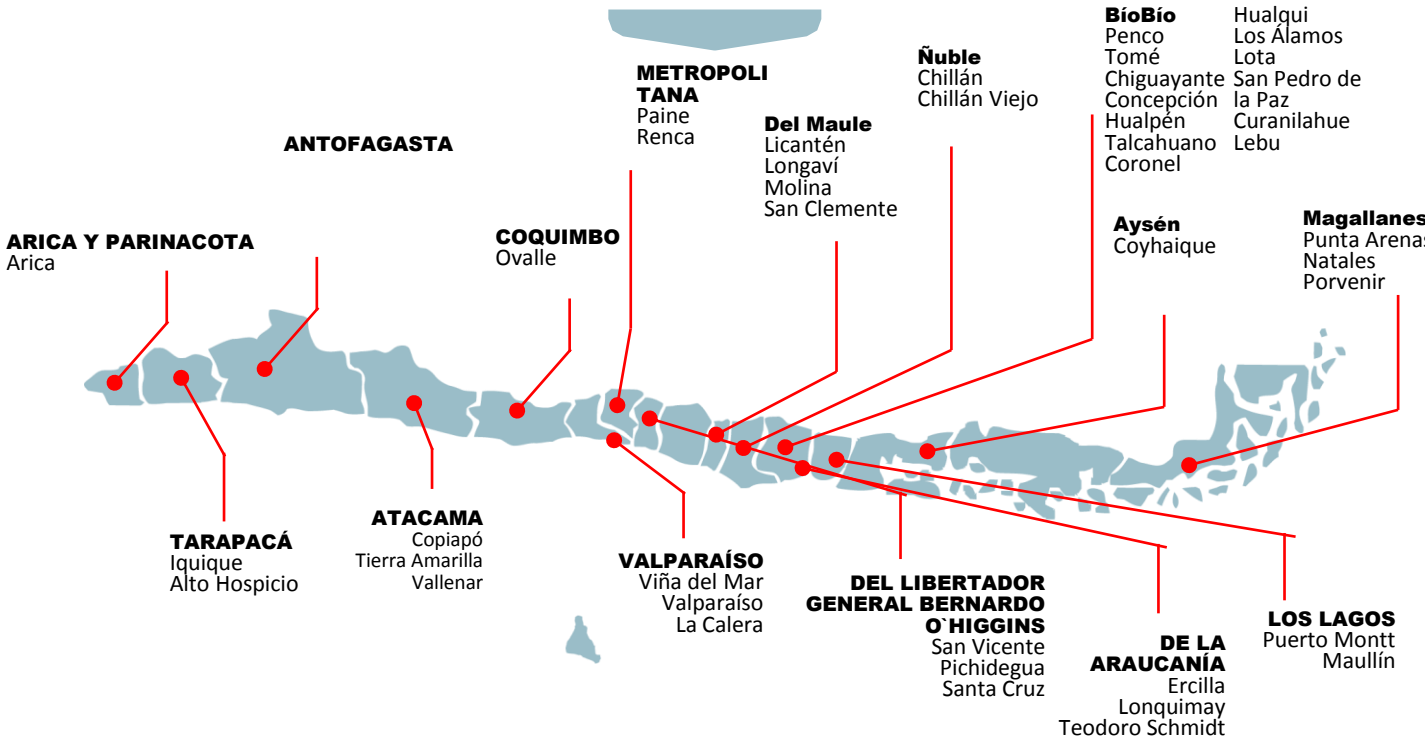

LATEST MEASURES



- The Undersecretary of Public Health, Paula Daza, flew over the Metropolitan Region on "Super Monday." The authority observed and verified the situation of the streets of the capital where, as of this Monday, the 28th, about 8 million people can circulate through Santiago.
- Ministry of Health implemented a new system for digitizing medical prescriptions. The objective of the mechanism is to facilitate the prescription of psychotropic and narcotic drugs during the pandemic. The measure will work with drugs that are purchased with a held prescription with balance control or with a check prescription.
- The Institute of Public Health (ISP) reported the list of IgG and IgM antibody kits that are reported on the official websites of regulatory authorities of high health surveillance in medical devices.
- Ministry of Health participated in the inauguration of a mobile clinic in Lo Barnechea. The Undersecretary of Assistance Networks, Arturo Zúñiga, highlighted the municipal initiative and assured that "it helps citizens to access their preventive controls, for cardiovascular, gynecological or respiratory diseases, which complements the work carried out by hospitals".
- Authorities of the Ministry of Health reported that as of Monday, September 28, twelve municipalities of the RM advance to the preparation phase and four enter quarantine in the south of the country.
