

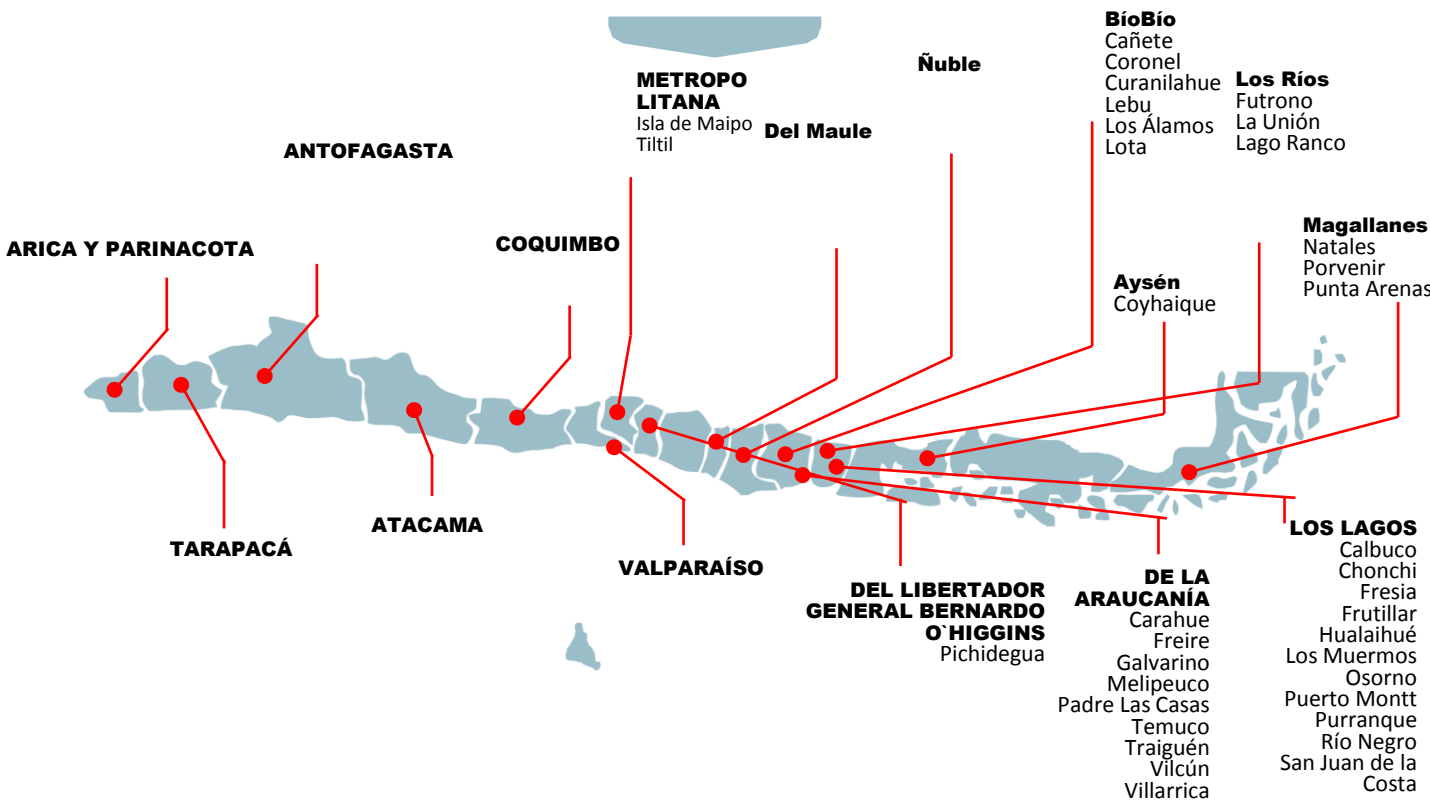

LATEST MEASURES



- Undersecretaries of Public Health and Crime Prevention delivered health recommendations in Lo Barnechea. Both authorities together with the mayor of the commune, Cristóbal Lira, made a call to strengthen self-care given the increase in the positivity of COVID-19 cases in the sector.
- The Ministry of Health made the 66th epidemiological report of COVID-19 and the 21st Weekly Report of Deaths from COVID-19 available to the community. The Minister of Health, Enrique Paris, highlighted that according to today's COVID-19 report, "1,568 new cases are reported, of which 27% originate from active case search (BAC) and 34% of those notified are asymptomatic.
- Pioneering sewage research was launched to help guide the Active Case Search in Chillán. The objective of the Initiative "Monitoring SARS-CoV-2 in Sewage in the city of Chillán" is to identify asymptomatic cases and detect positive cases early in the population at risk.
- Undersecretary of Public Health, Paula Daza, inaugurated a health squad and Mobile PCR in the Ñuble Region.
- Alberto Dougnac is appointed as the new Undersecretary of Healthcare Networks, replacing Arturo Zúñiga.
