

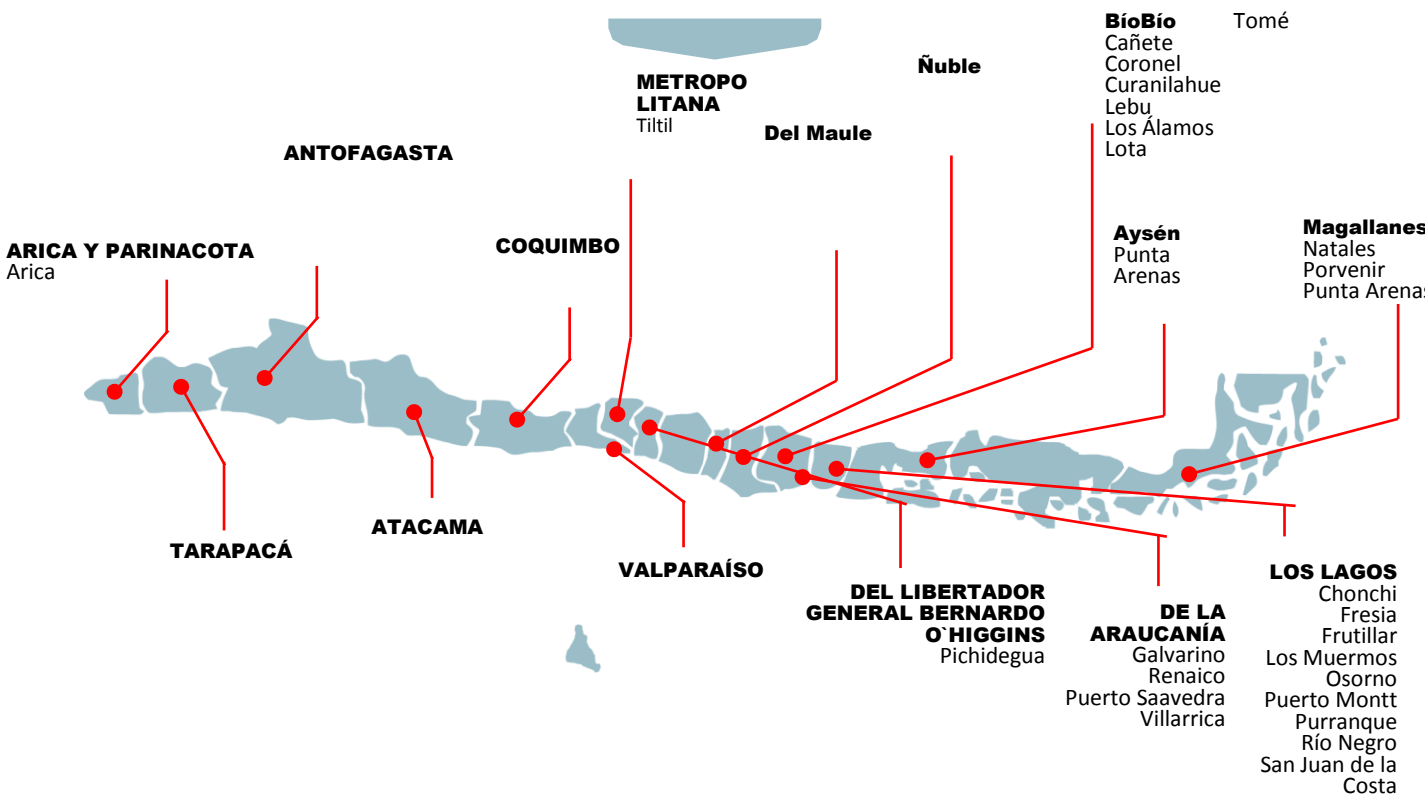

# LATEST MEASURES



- The Ministry of Health made the 62nd epidemiological report of COVID-19 and the 19th Weekly Report of Deaths from COVID-19 available to the community.
- Prior to the plebiscite, the health authorities called for respecting personal protection measures and made a donation of medical supplies to the Chilean Red Cross.
- The Institute of Public Health (ISP) published a SARS-CoV-2 antigen detection list from the National Regulatory Authorities belonging to the International Forum of Medical Device Regulators.
- The Third Joint Budget Subcommittee of Congress generally approved the budget line for the Ministry of Health for the year 2021. The budget of the Ministry of Health for the year 2021 reaches MM \$ 10,079,906.
- The Public Health Institute (ISP) informs the list of IgG and IgM antibody kits that are reported on the official websites of regulatory authorities of high health surveillance in medical devices.
