

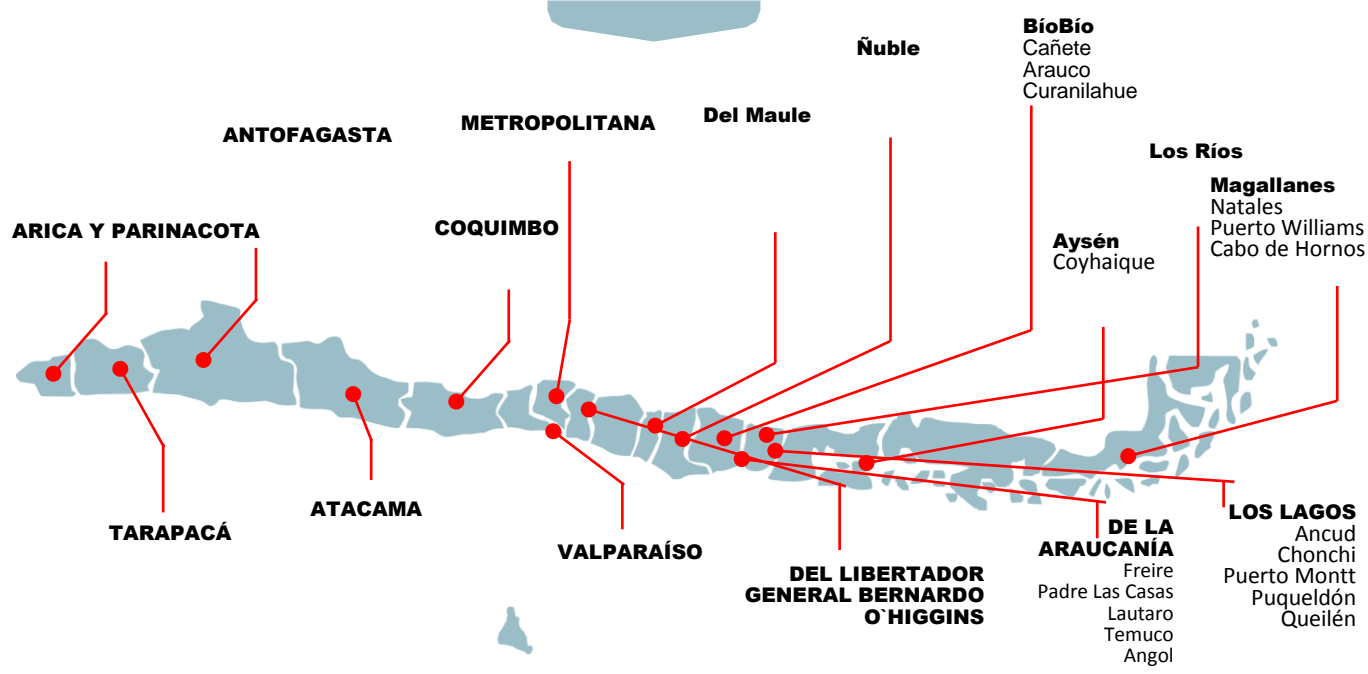

# LATEST MEASURES



- In a new report about the Coronavirus pandemic in Chile from the Palacio de La Moneda, the Minister of Health, Enrique Paris, pointed out that the average age of new positive cases of coronavirus is 39 years, so he did a call to responsibility. In addition, about the in the United Kingdom said that it has no indication of being more clinically aggressive and does not affect the effectiveness of vaccines.
- The Undersecretary of Crime Prevention Katherine Martorell, for her part, pointed out that as of Saturday, December 26, the Curfew schedule for the entire country will be brought forward at 22:00.
- While the Undersecretary of Health Paula Daza indicated that it will be audited and if it is necessary to close the places that do not comply with the regulations and called on the community not to expose themselves to these situations, since they view with concern the behavior in shopping centers and social gatherings, such as clandestine parties.
- Regarding the Christmas Plan, it was reported that on the 25th the Curfew will begin at 02:00 hours until 05:00 AM. And a special permit was added to visit older adults, with a maximum of 2 people.
- In relation to the New Year Plan, the Curfew of January 1 will be between 02:00 and 07:00 AM. In addition, there will be sanitary cordons in the macrozones from December 30 at 6:00 p.m. until January 2 at 5:00 a.m.
- The Metropolitan Region maintains the current measures (Step 2: Transition) and will be evaluated again on January 4.
